CCSS CALL FOR PEDIO STUDY – MICHAEL ROLL

Hello fellow CCSS club members.

This is Michael Roll, from the conservation committee. Did you know our club has a conservation committee? If so, hopefully you know about our Pediocactus simpsonii study. If not, let me take a moment and let you know how you can get involved. Over the course of the next several years we will be taking data on various pedio populations throughout the state. Why? Because nobody has! This is a very important native cactus in Colorado that has gotten little to no attention from researchers. Our goal is to create a baseline of data that may excite/help future researchers study this amazing cactus. Our data is basic but a great starting point to catalogue various populations around the state, especially unique characteristics such as size, clumping habits, flower color, etc....

So how can you get involved? Do you like to hike? Do you like to take pictures? How about discovering new populations of plants that have probably never been studied before? It's fun, it's exciting and it is very important work. We have created a data sheet that walks you through what data to collect at a pedio site. You take a few photos and mark the GPS location with your phone. The entire process takes about 45 min to 1.5 hrs. That's it! We will take your data and input the information into a database that we will make available to researchers upon request. <u>Don't</u> worry, locations of the population will not be available to the general public to <u>protect the plants.</u> It's easy and with so many pedio populations to be discovered I'm confident there's lots of work to be done for anyone and everyone who wants to get involved.

If you are interested contact me through email and we will set up a time for a little training, either in person or over the phone. Shouldn't take too long and we'll get you the nifty little research kit that has everything you need, except the phone. Very minimal amount is needed to carry. CACTUS OF THE MONTH:

Copiapoa -

A genus of flowering plants from the dry coastal deserts, particularly the Atacama Desert, of northern Chile.

It comprises 32 morphologically defined species and 5 heterotypic subspecies.

These species vary in form from spherical to slightly columnar and in color from a brownish to blue-green body. They have warty ribs and spiny areoles, and they usually produce tubular yellow flowers which grow from woolly crowns in summer.

SUCCULENT OF THE MONTH:

Euphorbia -

Euphorbia is a very large genus of plants with 2,000+ species. About 1,200 of them are succulents. Most Euphorbias bloom in spring or summer and go dormant in winter. The species are primarily found in the tropical and subtropical regions of Africa and Madagascar.

The milky sap the latex can produce extremely painful inflammation when in contact with mucous membranes. When large succulent spurges in a greenhouse are cut, vapours can cause irritation to the eyes and throat several metres away. Precautions, including sufficient ventilation, are required.
