Michelle DePrenger-Levin, Research Associate, studies applied plant conservation at Denver Botanic Gardens. She conducts field research on plant population dynamics and models species distributions, population level genetic structure and responses to climate change.

Michelle will discuss the scientific studies of the Research department that spans evolution and systematics to population ecology and single species demographics. This breadth and depth of scientific explorations enable us to conserve plant species and communities. Collaboration within our department played a key role in the recent delisting of a Federally listed Threaten cactus,*Sclerocactus glaucus*.
